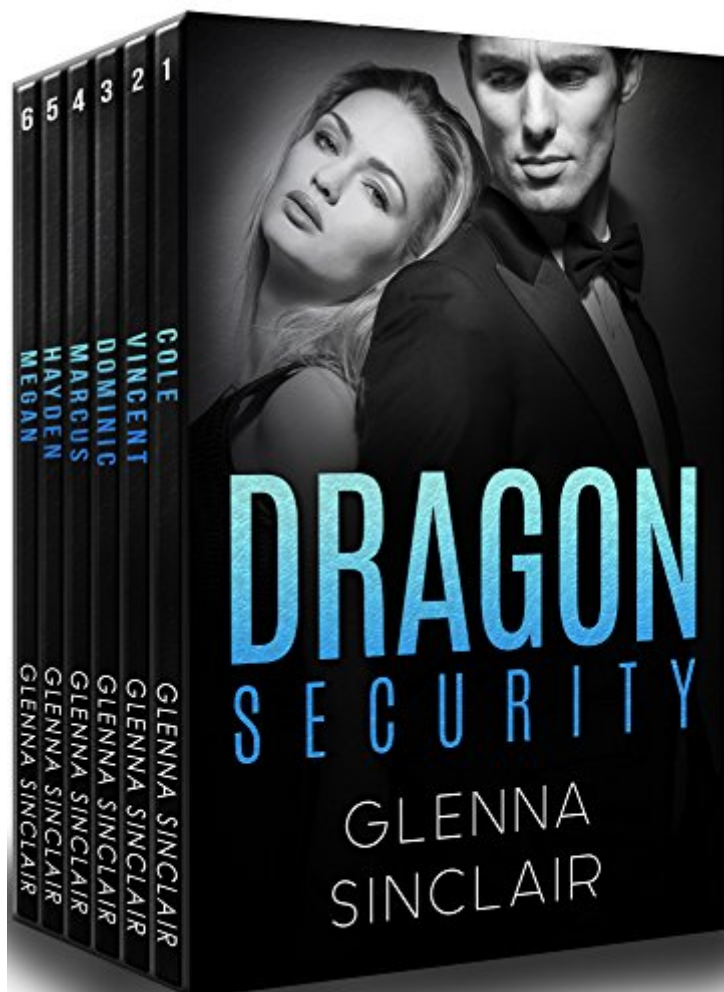

There were parts that were sad, and I was very glad I had the next book on hand to move past that, but I do feel that if a series is all sunshine and rainbows then you are missing out on the complexities that make characters real to readers.
