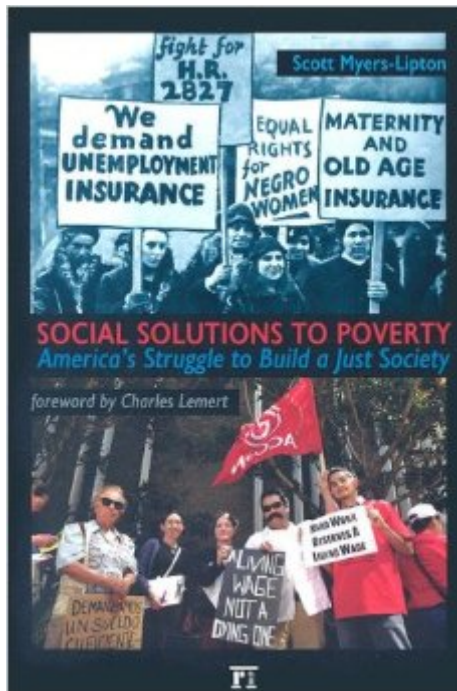

Bush's armies of compassion.
