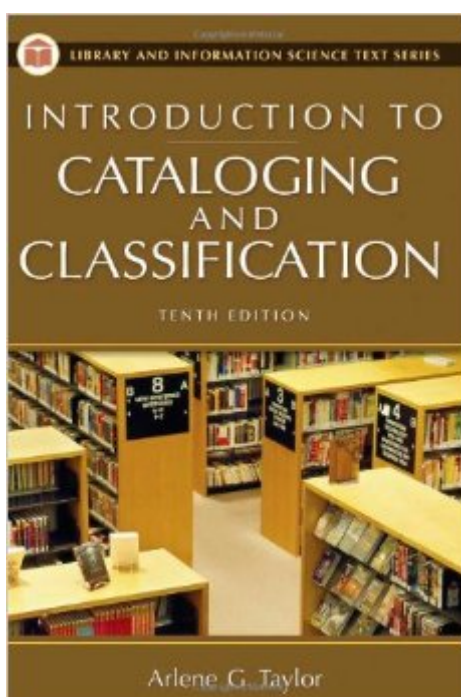

This is great resource, but it is out of date. It is nearly ten years old and, therefore, doesn't cover RDA, FRBR, or the myriad recent changes. There is, however, a new edition of this book (published in 2015) that is up to date Introduction to Cataloging and Classification (Library and Information

Science Text).

I found this book extremely helpful while obtaining my MLIS. There are plenty examples- and it comes with a CD for further assistance. Please note though that this is more of a guide book. It does not do the cataloging and classification for you.:Update:I will continue to say that this book is still helpful.
