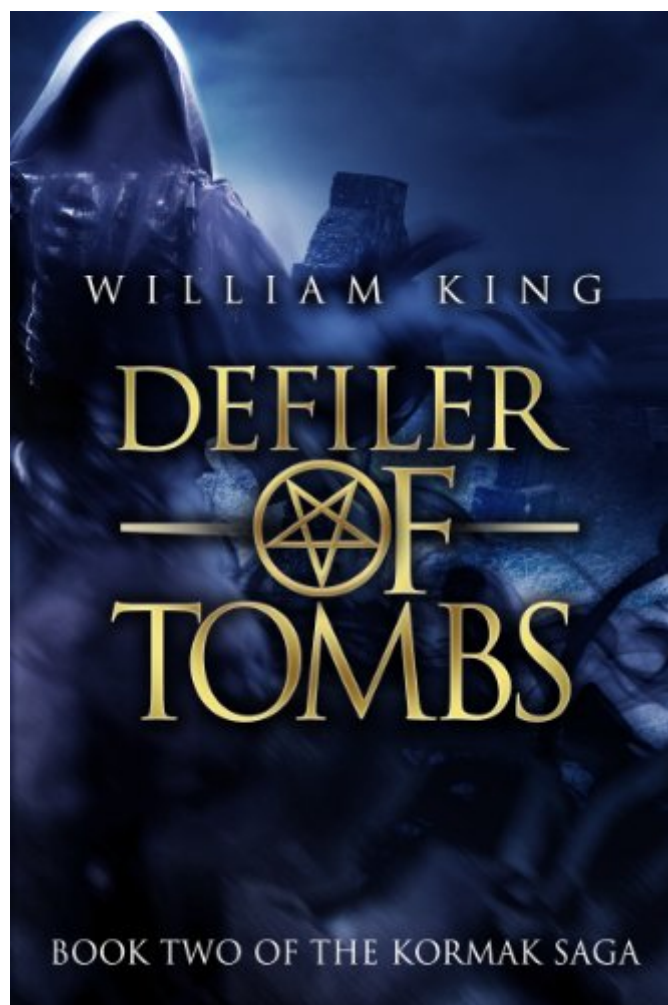

Another reader criticized this book because of the short story format of it. That is actually my favorite part of it. I remember the first book I read from William King was Trollslayer, it had the same format. Short stories merging together, Felix's reflections and insights on life, his self-honesty about his own motives, Gotrek's grim determination and pain masking a very loving heart. I see that here as well and it is lovely. In a very real way I am glad he is doing this outside of GW, no criticisms against those guys, but nothing is more vile than to see other authors take the wonderful personalities that King has breathed life into, and then ... well, "whore" is a harsh word, but there it is. At least with this series, I know no one is going to be butchering some wonderful characters and stories. In a good way, it hurts to read these stories. There is not just a genuineness to King's writing, but also a real love in him for all his characters. The bad guys are truly bad, they have made bad decisions they did not have to make save for selfishness, but at the same time you see clearly what they could have been, and that there was even much good in them as well that is lost when they die. The word for that is "tragedy". The worst tragedy of all wicked men is that they have all lived a life that could have been much more. There are only a few authors that have the heart to pull such a thing off. The first author that comes to mind when I think of King is Stevenson, there is the same realistic love for people in both these authors. The same common sense, the same genuineness, R.
