They are all intelligently written with wonderful characters and a great, unfolding mystery that links each book. If you need a riveting series of books, with smart, loving characters and believable magic, get them all! You won't be disappointed! Stacey is trying to balance her love life, help her cousin deal with having a baby, and battle a shape shifter who is trying to ruin her and her family. The book is so much fun to read because Stacey is as human as the rest of us even if she is the Seeker of Justice with a family of witches. There are plenty of twists and turns in this book and I can't say any more so I don't ruin it. The last chapters of the book revealed many surprises and I can't wait to see what's next.

This is a thrilling, well-plotted page turner with an eccentric cast of characters. The book description above does a wonderful job of summarizing this story so I won't go into details. I will only say this series keeps getting better & better. It is highly suggested by the author & me, that the books be read in sequence. (Start with Opal Fire!) To quote Ms Annino, "when the last page is turned, neither readers, nor the Seeker herself, will ever be the same."

I have really enjoyed the other books in the series but I noticed a couple of things this book which were distracting. First almost every chapter ends with foreshadowing, it loses its effect if it's used repetitively throughout the book. Second the references to pay events are getting a bit confusing - with so many books it's hard to remember everything. Overall I still like the series and with another cliffhanger ending there is sure to be a seventh.

As always these books keep the reader on their toes. The new characters mingled with the old and the ties that bind them together become clearer as the series continues. Stacy is always trying to play catch up as she tries to navigate her new role. A touch of romance mingled with mystery and Magic a perfect combination!

Fun, magical, some nice twists to the story. I have enjoyed each of these books in the series. This adds some new characters that will be interesting to follow in the future & brings back a character from a previous book that it was fun to meet again. I couldn't put it down & stayed up way too late to see it to the end.

Stacey Justice has been shot, sucked into another dimension, held captive in a bird cage, bitch-slapped by a goddess, groped by dead people ... the thing that scares her more than any of these is that she is in charge of planning a baby shower for her very pregnant and very baby-shower resistant cousin, Cinnamon. Stacy has her hands full with more than the party, however. Everyone is anticipating the arrival of the newest Geraghty, some with less enthusiasm than others. In addition to the whole baby thing, Stacy has issues to settle with her mother, her aunts, a ghost who doesn't know he's a ghost, shapeshifters, her former boyfriend, her current boyfriend, and her dog familiar, Thor. She's a busy girl in this Book 6 of the series. I always enjoy these books, and this one was just as good as the previous five. There was action, adventure, romance, magic, sword fights, ass-kicking, a possibly talking dog, more magic, romantic upheaval, you name it. I love the snappy dialogue between Stacy and Cinnamon, and I enjoy seeing Stacy come into her own with her witch skills. The tone of these books puts me in mind of the "Buffy the Vampire Slayer" TV series. Horrible things might happen, but people keep their sense of humor and put one foot in front of the other, doing the next right thing. As always with this series, I recommend the books be read in order, as one builds on the next. If this had been my first, however, it was good enough would have left me hungry to find out everything that brought the characters to this point.

Barbra Annino has exceeded any expectations I had about this 6th Stacy Justice book. It is witty twisty and just plain fun. Great plot and imaginative dialogue. Recommend reading in order and also SIN CITY GODDESS before starting this one.
