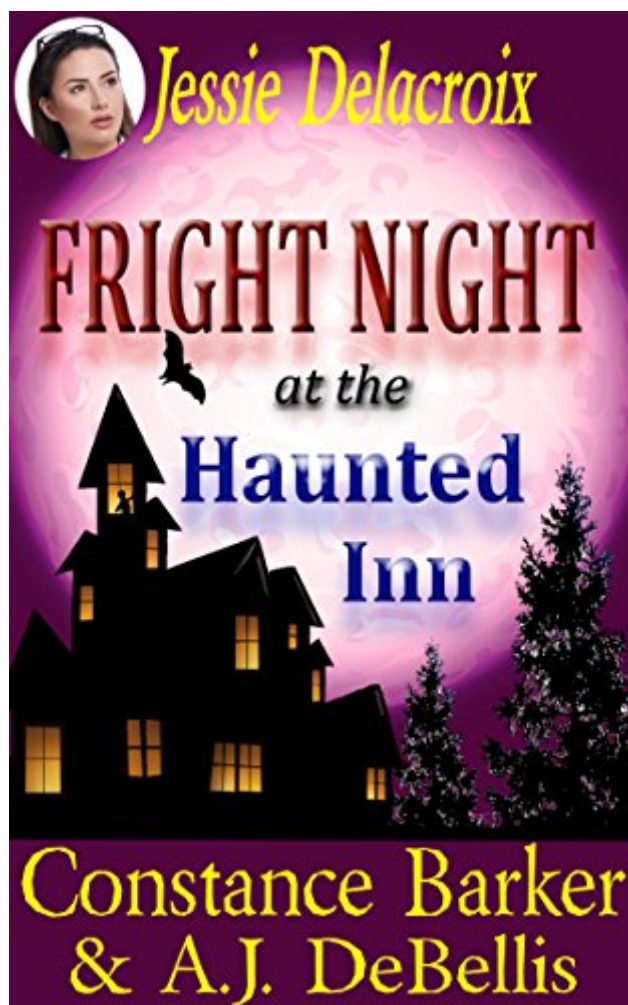

Is this satire? I have read all four to date. I think teens who like paranormal stories would like these. I thought the first three were better than this one. The authors just keep adding more types of fantasy/paranormal and they seem to try to have "Jessie" in her thoughts explain away inconsistencies. Don't get me wrong: they spin a good twisty yarn and some of the characters like Ginny are especially likeable. But they have pulled in soooo much---witches,ghosts,other universes or dimensions, Greek Ggods,magic artefacts,time travel, shape shifters,vampires,werewolves,----so much that especially this one,had me constantly trying to sort out who was who. The twenty something female in a small town with antiques,festivals and ghosts,is a very good start. But by book four--this one-- it seems like the authors are searching for reasons to have a murder and ways to make itsupernatural. Overall,fun stories in each book, with very well written characters,and a charming southern town I'd like to visit.
