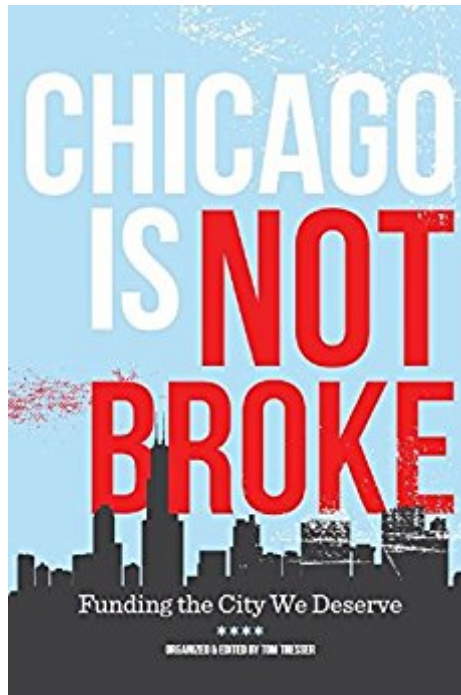

While most of the data presented is correct this book is more socialist fantasy -- a doubling down on

stupid -- that filters and distorts reality so far as to make their arguments little more than an unintelligible screed. The only solution they offer to the mismanagement and misspending of government (a valid complaint that I share with them) is more government and more spending. The book is an interesting look inside the parochial bubble of hard core leftist economics in Chicago today and a case study of how otherwise intelligent and educated people can delude themselves. Mao was right about one thing - periodically the intelligentsia needs to be flushed out of the cities and sent to toil at manual labor to reacquaint them with reality and humility.
