

I feel compelled to leave a review for Landfall by Jerry Aubin. Why, you may ask? Well, this freshman entry isn't perfect. There's a few moments where quite honestly I had to suspend my disbelief, or pause and excuse away a few items (ship designed for hundreds of years still functioning after 5000? The crew views the colonists as almost subhuman?) So why, you may also ask, is this a 5-Star review? Well, Mr. Aubin has created an engaging and completely believable world and story that sucks you in and doesn't let go! You immediately understand that Cadet's lives revolve around their position on the Leaderboard, and everything they do jockeys them to a better position and career. That any human society would fall into classes or castes, but what if an insular world was specifically created with the best-and-brightest as the leaders (Crew) and all their offspring is told they're the best of the best... constantly? Add in a heavy dash of mystery and "What-If" and you end up with a book that meets my basic criteria for receiving 5 stars...I couldn't stop reading it.
