I found the wisdom to be very thoughtful and the Bible verses to be perfect selections. Although beautiful, adoption is not an easy road. Being prepared for what to expect is invaluable and this study is an awesome way to pray over your family's next steps.

A touching combination of truth and grace. Parish tells it like it is, but approaches the emotional journey of fostering and adopting from a very gentle place. I thought I would read the whole thing in

one sitting, but taking it a day at a time has been a blessing. Each day was very impactful for me. It took 24 hours to digest most days! Parish brings insight to the table from many years of experience from her own fostering and adopting journey. The meditation and scripture at the end of each day was the highlight for me. This journey can feel hopeless, draining and lonely at times, but the reminder that we are not alone, that God is in control, offers hope. Having the scripture and reminders that we, as humans, cannot save a child, no matter how hard we try, and that God has chosen us to take this journey along side the children, is humbling and encouraging.

Pam Parish captures the biblical principles of foster care in such a concise, matter-of-fact way. This is a must read for those interested in fostering or supporting those who do foster. I have bought several to give to those in our support network, so they can further understand what we are going through.

I've worked with and for orphan care organizations for years, and have seen a glut of incorrect or incomplete information provided to prospective adoptive and foster parents. It's refreshing to find *Ready or Not* - a truly inspired and well-designed devotional that is chock-full of insight and holistic wisdom. I initially ran a test run of the early version of this book through our first foster families and as a couple with my husband when we were new foster parents. Pam guides you through the decision-making process about fostering and adoption with wisdom and sensitivity. She leads you

into sensitive areas that may have crossed your mind, but you've never put concrete thought to or articulated into words. For example, what will you do if your child presents with poor hygiene, how will you love this child unconditionally, what about your own biological children and meeting their needs? My husband and I read this book a second time once it was published and even though we were already fostering, we'd wished both times that we'd read it before we'd started. However, it still felt very applicable and helped us hone in on areas we needed to improve in our foster parenting. This book helps you count the cost of fostering and adoption. If I could, I would make it mandatory reading for all who are entering the world of foster care and adoption.
