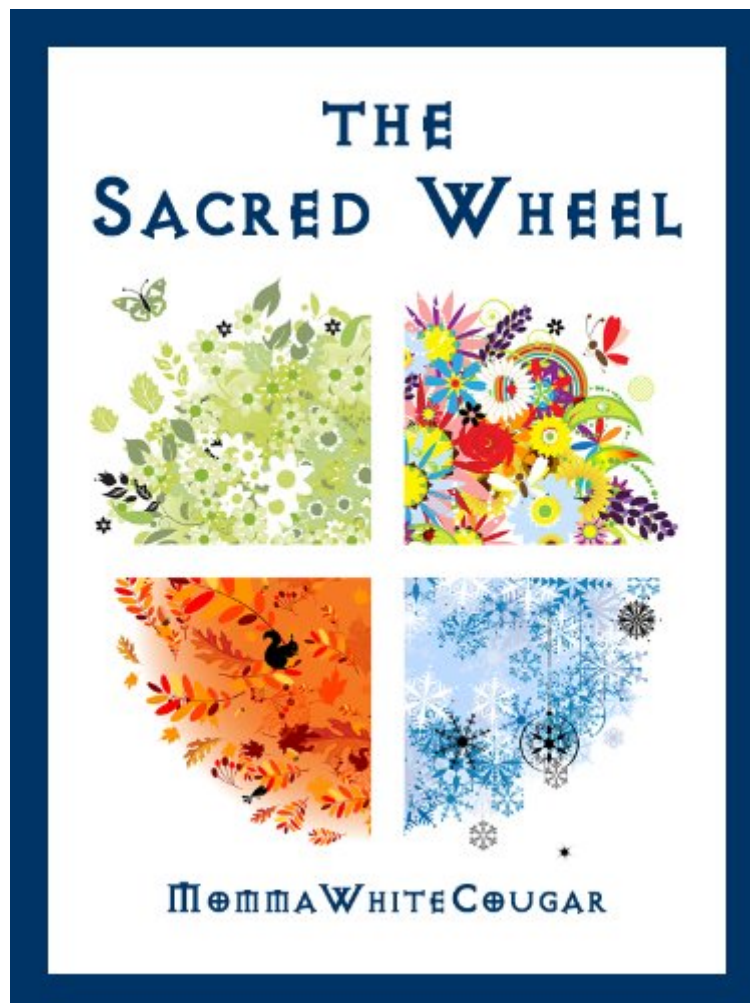

I'm not a Wicca practitioner but I've been looking for a book of seasonal celebrations based on the Wiccan wheel of the year. This has been a great read. It's clear this woman despises Christians, but other than her obvious disdain it's worth the read. I took off a star for her hating. Not that I don't understand it; I do. I'm not a religious person, myself (but was a religious studies major). I didn't like the jibes peppered throughout the book because it seems unnecessary and petty in light of all the great mythos she writes about. The *duh* factor of pagan origins to most Christian festivals speak for themselves without the snarky commentary. That being said, this book, though informative, is very personable and colloquial. She writes of her own journey, her own process, her own poems,

etc. This is a window to this woman's life in particular and a jumping off point for crafting your own rituals. I found it generally inspiring, humorous, practical, and [mostly] sensitive. If you're not interested in reading someone's story, forgo this title. But if, as in her opening, you are looking for a wise woman to sit down next to the fire with you and relay her successes and trials and anecdotes along her witchy path, this is the perfect book for you.

As with everything, this book came along in a very timely fashion. I had just started classes in Pagan/Wiccan spirituality when this was being released on . I decided to finally invest in a Kindle Fire, and the day after it arrived at my home, this download was free for a day! It is virtually a companion piece to my classes. Included here is information on quite a variety of Lords and Ladies. The ones that resonate with each of us will make themselves known to each person. I really like that all of that is included! The stories, songs, and poems personalize everything in a very lovely way. I'm very happy for the blessing of this book!

I've been practicing for several years now and have a ridiculously large library of Pagan books, meaning I don't need any more! But my new Kindle had just come and this was available for 'lending', so thought it would be a good way to adjust to the eReader. It didn't take long before I clicked to buy (at only \$2.99 a total steal). Humorous, well written, personal insights as well as historical ones this book has it all. While Pagans consider Samhain the end of one year, making Nov 1 the beginning of the new, this author wisely realized that the 'regular' New Year also needed an acknowledgement and includes a ritual. My only criticism is that this isn't available in a 'real' book format, because I'm old fashioned enough to still want that! Highly recommend, no matter what your level of knowledge is this book will enhance.

The Sacred Wheel is written in a conversational style that is so easy to read. It is written with both humour and sensitivity. There are autobiographical passages, short stories and poetry in addition to information about and suggestions for Celebrating the eight Wiccan Sabbats as well as Deities to honour at these times. There is even some Moon Magic! I think it is a good book for beginners, but even someone with lots of experience should find interesting things too. I highly recommend it!

Thought I haven't gotten too far into this book yet, it looks to be exactly what I am looking for...which is information, other ideas, other opinions. It touches on a lot of items, but not in a lot of detail. The writer continually says that she says little of hoe SHE does things so you find your own way of doing

things...not just copy her. She is VERY specific in that. That attitude, more than anything, I appreciate. I personally think I made a good and worth while purchase.

This ebook really does have something for everyone. The stories and poems are beautiful and thought provoking. Although I have my own path I find it interesting to read someone else's view of the the Wheel of the Year - sometimes finding something new I can add to my own rituals or information about a deity may pique my interest and drive me to research them further. I hope Momma WhiteCougar writes another book soon.
