Quick Overview This is reminiscent of the Science Fiction of Star Trek, Star Wars and Battlestar Gallactica of the 1970s. By that, I mean, a return to battle stations and with language that most parents wonâ™t have trouble letting their youngsters be exposed to. Mild epithets, such as damn and words that describe oneâ™s posterior or its
