

Dennis Dalton, editor, is a Gandhi scholar and professor of political science. This collection of Gandhi's political writing is the best introduction to Gandhi's thinking that I have found. Professor Dalton's Introduction and the structuring of the writings quickly give the reader a framework in which Gandhi's life and work can be clearly comprehended.

This is one of my favorite books. It is an excellent collection of Ghandhi's political writings from when he returned to India. However, the writings also give a good insight in to Ghandhi's spiritual beliefs and thoughts on God. If you have always been curious about Ghandhi's life and how he developed his philosophy of Satyagraha and Swaraj, the foreword provides a brief but thorough

exploration of his life leading up to his return to India, including his time in England and South Africa.
