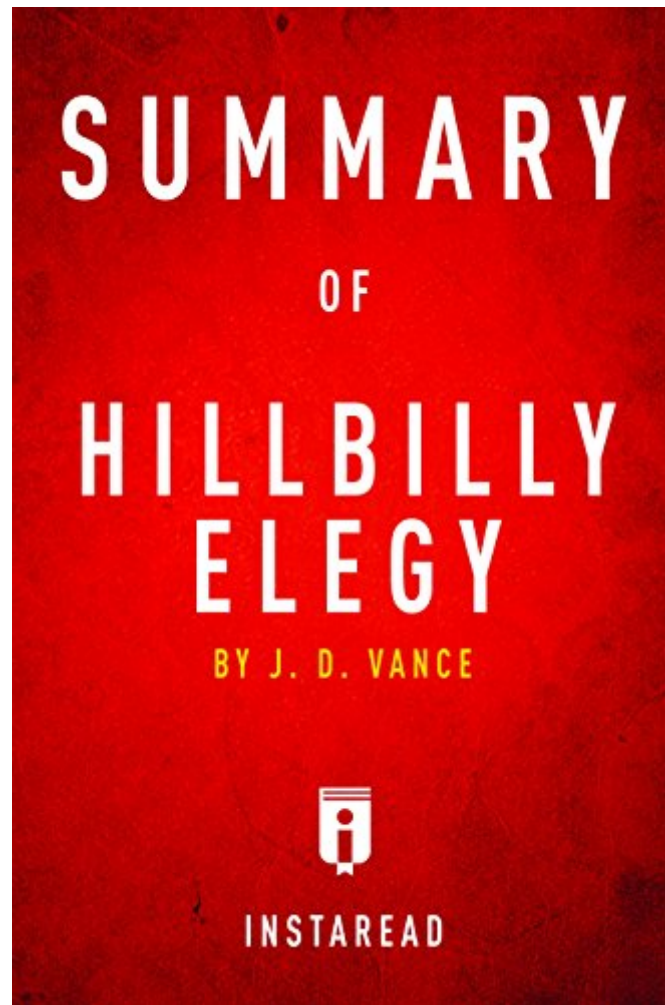

J.D. Vance, the author of Hillbilly Elegy, grew up in a poor white working class family, but went on to graduate from Yale Law School. In his book, he attempts to explain the situation for working class whites who live in America's Rust Belt, the hillbillies of the country, and how they must take some personal responsibility for their lives rather than just sit back and complain. This appears to be a politically neutral explanation for much of the political anger that has upended American politics, and should probably be read by anyone who wishes to have a better understanding of the phenomenon.
