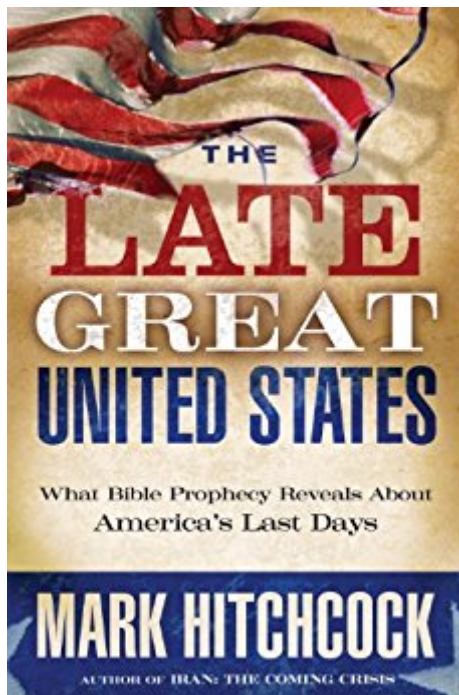

Claiming that the Ten Tribes returned to the Holy Land with the Jews at the end of the Babylonian exile ignores what the Bible teaches. 1. The worldâ™s entire population of Jews, throughout all history, does not constitute as many persons as there are stars in the sky or grains of sand on the seashore, as God promised Abraham that his descendants would be, Genesis 22:17.3. God promised Abraham and Sarah that their descendants would become multiple nations, Genesis 17:4-5, 16.4. God, through Jacob, promised Joseph that his descendants would become multiple nations, Genesis 48:19.4.
