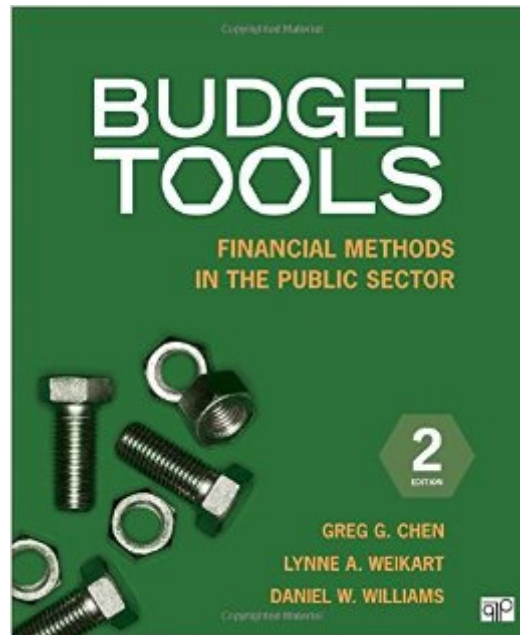

The previous edition had a CD. Does this one? There is no mention anywhere of any access to the referred to exercises. This is a huge problem.
