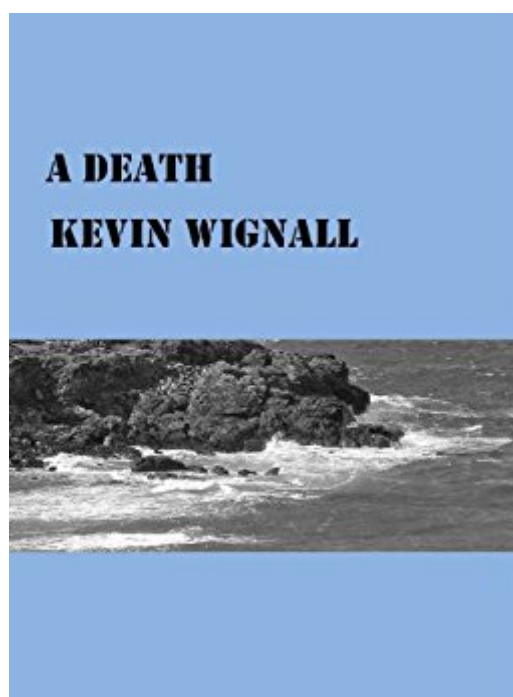

## Synopsis
